



RMTDW Policies for the Men's and Women's Weekends

Approved by the RMTDW Secretariat February 8, 2022

Note: These are not intended to supersede or replace the Tres Dias International Essentials and are to clarify recent practical policy decisions.

1. Participants:

- a. All participants (team and candidates) in a RMTDW weekend should have an active personal relationship with Jesus, based on faith and demonstrated by piety, study, and action. (1/11/22)
- b. Participants must adhere to the RMTDW Statement of Belief (1/11/22)
- c. Participants must not be living unrepentant lives. (1/11/22)
- d. Participants must not be attending a church generally considered a cult (e.g. JW or LDS) (1/11/22)

2. Financial:

- a. Team and candidate fees are non-refundable. Exceptions must be approved by the Secretariat. (6/11/20)
- b. Team fees must be completely paid by the 2nd team meeting. (8/28/21). Candidate fees are due by sign-in on Thursday evening of the weekend. Sponsors are responsible to see that this is paid. (2/8/22).
- c. If fees are paid and someone needs to cancel out due to unforeseen circumstances, the fees could be applied to the next weekend.
- d. Scholarships for team will only be offered once per person, and a maximum of \$100. (8/28/21). Head CHA will decide who is eligible. (2/8/22)
- e. Spiritual directors also need to pay team fees. (2/1/20). If they are serving on both weekends, they only need to pay fees for one. (2/8/22).

3. Weekends:

- a. It is highly recommended that team members attend as many pre-weekend meetings as possible, to allow for team building and to critique Rollos. Exceptions to be discussed with Rector/Rectora. (1/11/22)
- b. Cell phones are not allowed except for designated team members for use in emergencies. (2/1/20)
- c. Speakers, including spiritual directors, must follow Rollo outlines. (2/1/20)
- d. Speakers are highly encouraged to dress nicely (business attire) for delivering Rollos. (2/1/20)

e. These are cloistered weekends. Spiritual directors may leave and return only for emergencies, as approved by the Head Spiritual director and Rector/Rectora. Team members who must arrive late or leave early for necessary functions must have approval of the Rector/Rectora, otherwise no team member is to leave other than the “gopher”, and then they should be “prayed up and “down. (2/1/20)

f. Inventory sheets must be filled out by head CHAs (for their area of responsibility), and given to the weekend couple at the end of the weekend. (2/1/20)

g. CHAs must review job descriptions for their area.

4. Miscellaneous:

RMTDW Rules and Regulations, page 2

a. RMTDW properties, including Roman soldier uniforms, are not to be loaned out. (2/1/20)

b. Children > 5 years old should not be at “closing” because of potentially sensitive material. (2/1/20)

c. No persons other than community members or clergy are allowed at closing. (2/8/22)

Note: The dates in parentheses are the dates these items were voted on by the Secretariat.
